CANOEING

Beginning just downriver from the Lodge, the trip meanders along 6 miles of the Macal River through moderate rapids and verdant rainforest. Guests often see large green female Iguanas and even bigger orange male iguanas, or "Garobos", as well as Wood Rails, Toucans, King Fishers, and Hummingbirds. Guests dock at Chaa Creek Lodge and can choose to visit the Blue Morpho Butterfly Center and Natural History Museum. We then pick up the guests and drive them back to Black Rock Lodge.

(Minimum: 2 persons. Age limit: 8 years and above)

RIVER TUBING

Discover the beauty of the Macal River and the surrounding rainforest while relaxing in a tube as the scenery floats by. Starting a mile up from the Lodge, guests float through cascades and deep pools along the way

(Age limit: Tubing without Black Rock Waterfall: 8 years and above. Tubing with Black Rock Waterfall: 12 years and above. ALWAYS WITH ADULT SUPERVISION)

GUIDED HORSEBACK RIDING

Enjoy riding through the Canyon and along the Maçal River on one of our 8 well-trained horses. Explore Flour Camp Cave (actually a number of caves with several entrances and exits) and discover Maya pottery, stalagmites, and stalactites. Or, ride to the unexcavated Maya ruin site of Tipu following a beautiful hillside trail with terrific vistas of the valley. Another option is the Vaca Falls trail, an easier ride providing great views of the River, Canyon and Falls

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Explore miles of jungle trails and dirt roads on top quality Cannondale mountain bikes. Take a bathing suit and stop for a swim along the way.

GUIDED HIKING

Hike through the rainforest on miles of marked trails leaving from Black Rock Lodge to various destinations such as Flour Camp Cave, Key Hole Cave, the Mountain Summit, Vaca Falls, the Vista Loop or the Cliff Trail. Black Rock guides will be sure to point out interesting flora and fauna along the way.

(Minimum: 2 persons. Age Limit: none)

GUIDED EARLY MORNING BIRDING

Black Rock's incredible location on the banks of the Macal River, lends itself to witnessing scores of beautiful tropical birds. During the winter months the population doubles as migratory birds fly south from Canada and the U.S. See Hummingbirds, three species of Toucans, Parrots, the Orange Breasted Falcon, Lineated and Pale-bill Woodpeckers, Trogons, White Hawks, King Vultures, Flycatchers.

GUIDED NIGHT HIKE

Many of Belize's animals are nocturnal. Although there can be no guarantee that certain wildlife will appear for each hike, typically guests see tarantulas, kinkajous, snakes, owls, tyras, quatumundis and more.
